CIO Award - 2003

NIE was awarded with the CIO Award for achieving excellence in strategic enterprise IT deployment. The CIO 100 is an annual index of Asia's Top 100 enterprise users of IT that have leveraged the use of information technology to derive the highest strategic value and yield the greatest returns for their businesses. CIO 100 Honorees are chosen as role models for other organizations to learn from and emulate in achieving long-term strategic success. The nominees for the award are required to identify new innovative uses of IT or business initiatives that have made a significant impact on their organization. NIE was awarded based on its submission - the Secure Single Sign-on Staff Portal Initiative.

BEA Award - 2003

The BEA Award is given to organizations which are early adopters worldwide of the BEA Portal 8.1 in their Information and Communications Technology strategic Implementation. NIE was awarded for adopting the relatively new technology in the construction and implementation of its Staff Portal.

CIO-IHLs MOU Signing - 2004

The non-binding Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was a step towards promoting communication, cooperation, collaboration and community spirit among the Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL) in Singapore. The IHLs involved were the Institute of Technical Education, Nanyang Polytechnic, Nanyang Technological University, National Institute of Education, National University of Singapore, Ngee Ann Polytechnic, Republic Polytechnic, Singapore Management University, Singapore Polytechnic and Temasek Polytechnic.

CIO Award - 2005

NIE was ranked among Asia's top 100 organisations to have achieved excellence in the strategic use of Information Technology (IT) for business and operations. Specifically, NIE was listed for its application of the Oracle 9i AS and i-Sprint AccessMatrix security solutions for the Staff Portal to streamline operations and improve work efficiency and productivity. Being in the CIO 100 listing for the second time proves that NIE has shown herself to be a role model for other organisations to learn from and emulate in achieving long-term strategic success.

CIO Award - 2011

NIE was awarded with the CIO 100 Award for actively adopting energy efficient technology and hardware to run a much greener Data Centre. The renewed Data Centre has an enhanced operation efficiency and resiliency, and requires less management resources. More importantly, NIE's Computer Services Centre maintains and supports a suite of applications for about 1,000 staff and 5,000 students. The student intake is expected to increase over the next three years. With this transformation initiative now completed, NIE is now equipped with the IT capability to support the growing demands from end users well beyond 2012.
