

THE ACADEMIC UNIT SYSTEM

Core Modules, Prescribed Electives & General Electives

There are three categories of subject modules in the degree courses:

Core Modules : Compulsory modules that must be passed to fulfil degree course requirements (inclusive of Essential Modules);

Prescribed Electives : Electives that form a certain field of specialisation in a particular subject. They add to the depth and/or breadth of knowledge and skills to be acquired by trainee teachers;

General Electives : Electives which may be chosen from a broad list of modules offered by the University, whether within or outside the Institute, on the approval of the Dean.

Each module is assigned academic units. Minimum academic unit requirements for completing the Pass degree and Honours degree courses are shown in Tables 1A and 1B. Note that in addition to the core modules and the required number of prescribed electives, trainee teachers must also offer general electives which can be chosen from subjects offered. The number of general electives they offer depends on their subject combinations as well as level of specialisation.

BA/BSc (ED) COURSES

- Curriculum Content (CC)
(Those specialising in Malay Language & Literature or Physical Education do not offer this component.)
- Academic Subjects (AS)
- Practicum
- General Electives (GE)

Essential Modules

As part of the core curriculum, all trainee teachers must offer 4 essential modules of 3 AUs each. Three modules are compulsory for all trainee teachers. These are:

- CEM101 Environmental Studies and Global Issues
- CEM102 Critical Reading and Writing
- CEM201 The Teacher and Society

For BA(Ed) trainee teachers, the fourth Essential Module is

- CEM202 Multicultural Studies

For BSc(Ed) trainee teachers, the fourth Essential Module is

- CEM203 Science and Civilisation
- CEM204 Health & Wellness(for PE specialisation only)

Upon admission, all trainee teachers are required to sit for the English Qualifying Test (EQT). The results of this test will determine whether they will be exempted from the modules, CEM103, Language Communication Skills or CEM104, Oral Communication Skills. Unless exempted, these two essential modules must be passed in order to fulfil degree requirements.

Education Studies

This category of study is compulsory, and should be taken by all degree trainee teachers.

Curriculum Content

Academic Subjects

This area of study covers knowledge of the content of the subject and its fundamental concepts and principles.

Trainee teachers on Primary course must choose one Academic Subject to study throughout the course.

A BA(Ed) trainee teacher must choose one Arts Academic Subject. Similarly, a BSc(Ed) trainee teacher must choose one Science Academic Subject. The list of subjects are shown below:
