### Notes:

1. It is possible for full-time students to take up to 6 courses of 4AUs each in Year 1, and commence their dissertation in Year 2. It is assumed that they will be able to complete their dissertation in one-and-a-half years, i.e., by end of Year 3.

2. Part-time students will normally take 4 courses in Year 1 and 2 courses in Year 2 and commence their dissertation in Year 3. It is assumed that they will complete their dissertation in two years, i.e., by end of Year 4.
3. All fees listed above are in Singapore dollars (S\$). Every academic year, fees are reviewed and subject to revision. As and when fees are revised, the new fees will be applicable to all existing and new students. Fees are subject to applicable GST.
4. There are two semesters in an academic year. Fees payable every semester must be paid in advance and within the stipulated period.
5. Students have to pay for any component that they need to repeat.
6. Persons who fail to pay fees within the stipulated periods can have their names removed from the register of higher degree students. A person whose name has been thus removed but who is otherwise eligible to continue his candidature will be reinstated only after he has settled all outstanding fees and paid a re-registration fee of S\$53.50 (inclusive of GST).
7. A student who withdraws or leaves the University two or more weeks after the commencement of his candidature or the commencement of the semester is liable to pay the fees due for the semester.
8. The University's Board of Trustees reserves the right to alter fees at any time without notice.

A person whose name has been thus removed but who is otherwise eligible to continue his candidature will be reinstated only after he has settled all outstanding fees and paid a re-registration fee of S\$53.50.
- Candidates who withdraw from the programme within the first 2 weeks of the first semester shall not be liable for the Tuition Fee, and Miscellaneous Fees. Candidates who withdraw from the programme after the second week shall be liable for payment of Tuition Fee, and Miscellaneous Fees due for the entire semester.
- With effect from AY2018-19, all full-time students will be liable for the Health Service Fee until the conferment of their degree. For further clarification, please approach NIE Student Services Centre for assistance.
