The guidelines above serve as a general guide on contingency plans that PESS will undertake in the event of haze. However, we will exercise some personal judgement and consider some of the following factors listed below to decide if we should move classes indoors or to cancel classes. We may also consult the lecturers concerned before making a decision.

- NEA 3 hour PSI level – this will provide a more accurate gauge as to the current haze situation compared to the 24-hour PSI level
- NEA 1 hour PM2.5 level
- Current trend of PSI – if PSI level is worsening by the hour
- Intensity level of physical activities carried out during classes
- Duration of classes
- Other factors such as availability of indoor facilities and contents of modules
